Hatfield Woodhouse Primary became an academy in April 2012.

- We are a rural primary school serving the local community and outlying villages.
- Only **16.05%** live within the village of Hatfield Woodhouse, the rest are either bussed in or are driven in. (35 pupils)
- **197 pupils** on roll and **21 pupils in FS1. (218 in total)**
- Foundation Stage comprises of a morning FS1 class and a full-time FS2 class. Parents are offered the opportunity to take up additional hours in FS during the afternoon. Other classes are single form entry.
- The majority of the pupils are **White British**.
- **5.96%** are travellers or from showmen families who regularly travel for work (13 children)
- **1.8%** are LAC (4 pupils)
- **6.85%** are FSM (15 children)
- **14.67%** are classed as disadvantages (32 children)
- There are 24 children on our SEN register (11%), 3 of them statemented/EHCP children.
- The social and economic characteristics of the catchment area are mixed. The local authority deprivation index (IMD) ranks the school at a **4** indicating that deprivation is slightly above the national average and in line with that of the average for Doncaster itself. The highest proportion of families meeting this category are in our FS and lower KS2. The IDCI ranks the school slightly better than the IMD as **5**. On the new ASP report we are classed as 0.2 on the school based deprivation indicator.

Staffing

We have 8 teachers – 1 of whom is part-time.

The Vice Principal joined school in September 15.

Our inclusion manager is currently on secondment to another academy.
