Pupils and staff are celebrating an “amazing” set of results.

We saw numbers meeting the expected standard in reading, writing and maths rise by 11.7% over the past 12 months to 86.7%, above the national average which was 64%.

The Key Stage 2 SATs were taken by Year 6 in May, with results released by the Department for Education this month.

Principal Helen Acton was “very proud” of the results across Delta Academies Trust.
