Year 1 have loved learning about the seasons and the weather this week.

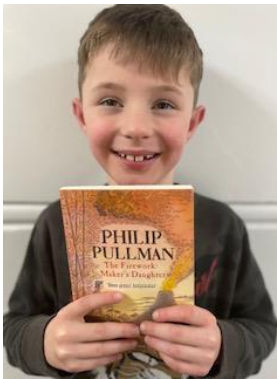
