**Hedgehogs - Year 1**

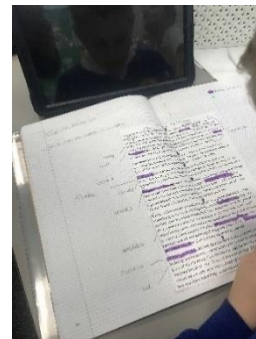
Last week we had a fun time in science. We had to work out what the best material would be to keep Samuel Pepys' diary dry when he buried it.
