Owls - Year 3

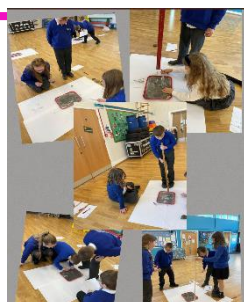
In maths this week, Year 4 have been investigating the area of shapes. We started the week off by using post it notes to see how many shapes we could make with the same area.
