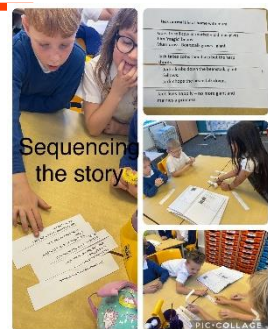
### **Hedgehogs - Year 1**
